PLAYERS' INFORMATION

SPECIAL COVID-19 INFORMATION

Golf Etiquette, Behaviour Expectations and General Conduct during Play

- Always adhere to recommended social distancing measures
- No shaking hands and contact of any kind (fist bumps, high fives, hugs...)
- Wash your hands with soap and water frequently and before and after each round
- If soap and water are not readily available, use hand sanitiser
- Sanitise hands after each hole
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth
- Sneeze or cough into a tissue, or inside your elbow; absolutely no spitting
- Wear a mask while onsite and in the designated areas (subject to local health guidelines).

Players must make every effort to fulfil normal tasks during a round of golf, including but not limited to:

- Removing, raking and replacing the rake in the bunkers (sanitise hands before and after use of the rake)
- Removing, tending and replacing the flagsticks (sanitise hands before and after use of the flagstick)
- Retrieving the golf ball from the hole
- Repairing pitch marks and divots

Travel

PLEASE DO NOT TRAVEL IF:

- in the past 7 days you have had any of the COVID-19 symptoms:
 - fever or chills
 - cough
 - sore throat
 - unusual fatigue
 - unusual shortness of breath when I'm speaking or making the slightest effort
 - muscle pain and/or unusual body aches and pains
 - unexpected headache
 - loss of taste or smell
 - congestion or runny nose
 - unusual diarrhoea
- someone you live with has had these symptoms in the previous 14 days
- you have had direct contact (within 1 metre for more than 15 minutes) with someone diagnosed with COVID-19 in the 14 days prior to travel.

PRECAUTIONS TO BE TAKEN:

- **When travelling:**
 - **Protect yourself and others by following health measures (wear a mask and sanitise hands). You must travel with a minimum supply of masks and alcohol-based (60% minimum) hand sanitiser.**
 - **Avoid public transport when possible and drive yourself wherever possible.**

GENERAL RECOMMENDATIONS:

- **Players will be responsible for their own transportation, to/from airports, golf courses, hotels, restaurants, etc., at their own cost.**
- **Players are encouraged to drive their own cars where possible.**
- **If air travel is used, players are encouraged to buy direct flights then rent a car to the venue.**
- **Sharing a room with another player or a guest is allowed.**
- **Restaurants outside the tournament venue: we strongly recommend that players take every precaution in terms of social distancing and personal hygiene to minimise risk when dining outside. Eating in the hotel room or in the rental apartment or villa should be considered when possible.**

If a player shares a car or a room with someone, both persons will have to fill in a form in which they declare that they know the other person, agree to share the car and/or the room and will follow the local health guidelines.

TRAVEL RESTRICTIONS TO ITALY (updated on 5th March)

Belgium, Bulgaria, Cyprus, Croatia, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Ireland, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, The Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, Czech Republic, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Hungary, Island, Norway, Liechtenstein, Swiss, Andorra, Monaco.

Those who enter/return to Italy from these countries (after a stay or even only transit) and until further notice, must also **present a statement that they have undergone a molecular or antigenic test carried out by means of a swab and a negative result within 48 hours before entering Italy.**

Travel from AUSTRIA

From 5th March to further notice, persons visiting or transiting through Austria for more than twelve hours within the last 14 days are allowed entry to Italy only if they **present to the carrier on boarding, and to any other control authority, a negative molecular or antigenic swab test result taken within 48 hours before entering Italy.**

Travel from the UK & Northern Ireland

Travellers visiting or transiting through the UK in the 14-day period prior to their entry to Italy are allowed entry to Italy only if resident in the country since before 23 December 2020 or for essential reasons (in which case they must specify, in the self-declaration form, whether they are returning home or the essential reason for travelling). In these cases, travellers are allowed entry to Italy only if they **present to the carrier on boarding, and to any other control authority, a negative molecular or antigenic swab test result carried out no earlier than 72 hours before entering Italy.**

IMPORTANT: PROFESSIONAL ATHLETES, ELITE AMATEURS ARE ALLOWED TO ENTER IN ITALY WITHOUT RESTRICTIONS.

ALPS TOUR WILL PROVIDE AN OFFICIAL LETTER TO PROVE WORK REQUIREMENT TO ALL PLAYERS AND ALLOW THEM TO AVOID THE QUARANTINE AT THEIR ARRIVAL IN ITALY.

The requirement to fill in a **self-declaration** remains (document provided at airport or borders).

On site Covid-19 Checks

VERY IMPORTANT: BEFORE THE TOURNAMENT:

Considering the global situation in Europe, and even if it is not possible to create a 'Tournament Bubble' for this tournament due to lack of large hotels, all players, staff and guests are subject to mandatory Covid-19 testing before their arrival on site.

All players (including Italian residents), staff and guests must bring an official, printed certificate (SMS and digital certificates will not be accepted), certifying that they have undergone a molecular or antigenic test carried out by mean of a swab and a negative result within 72 hours before the tournament registration deadline.

In addition, every morning of the week and before to access any Golf Club facilities, players, caddies, staff and coaches must stop first at the **Health Check Point** for the following operations:

- Temperature check
- Symptoms check.

Upon their first arrival, players must also fill out the Medical Questionnaire and return it to the Tournament office.

If the temperature is under the threshold (37.5) and there are no other symptoms, players will have access to all facilities.

If the temperature is above the threshold and/or there are some other symptoms, players will have to leave the venue immediately, return to their hotel room or home and wait for a medical assessment with the referring tournament doctor.

For those who require a **PCR test to return** their country of residence, testing will be available onsite at their own cost (approx. 50€/60€). More details will be given onsite.

If a player wakes up and feels unwell, he must stay in his room and contact the tournament office as soon as possible, especially if he has any symptoms of Covid-19.

Intentional breach of the regulations and healthy measures will be penalised and that may extend to removal from the tournament.
